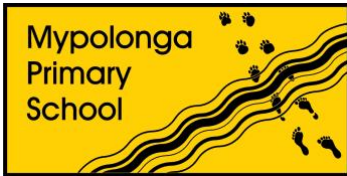

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Take photos using the 'Types of Photos' Guide 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A close up
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Download all photos into This Week's Photos, deleting any, which are not effective. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> An unusual angle
